Nursing Honors Admission Application v01.2025

Introduction

The BS Honors Program of the University of Colorado, College of Nursing provides a unique undergraduate research opportunity. Students who are selected for the Honors program will take an additional six credits of electives, above and beyond the Traditional Pathway baccalaureate requirements. These credits focus on research and scholarship. Note that Honors Program students are responsible for covering the first semester of additional tuition costs associated with the program; after the first semester, additional tuition costs for the program are covered by the College of Nursing.

A benefit for the Nursing honors students is the individualized mentorship in scholarly inquiry, the chance to apply critical thinking skills to the development of a testable research hypothesis, and the opportunity to develop and refine writing and speaking skills.

Typically, there are up to six honors spots designated in each admission cohort for the BS Traditional Pathway.

Eligibility

To be considered for the nursing honors program you must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Apply for admission to the CU College of Nursing program (Traditional Pathway) and meet admission requirements for acceptance in the BSN program.
- 2. Complete and submit the Nursing Honors Admission Packet to the College of Nursing Admissions office.
 - a. The Nursing Honors Admission Application
 - b. Attach a 1-page resume or curriculum vitae that includes all pertinent activities and affiliations in which you are currently active or have been active during the past 3 years. Include positions held, dates, publications, honors, extracurricular activities, volunteer activities and areas of research if applicable.
 - c. Honors Program Student Questionnaire
 - d. Submit two recommendations using the forms provided. The recommendation should come from a faculty from your last educational experience or a supervisor from a recent research experience.
 - e. Honors Essay: a 500-word essay describing:
 - i. Why you believe you should be selected for the honorstrack
 - ii. The areas of research are you interested in studying
 - iii. The personal strengths or characteristics you possess that you believe will facilitate your research interests
 - iv. How you expect to benefit from participation in the program
 - v. How the honors program might influence your career trajectory?

The honors essay will be evaluated on content, presentation and grammar.

3. Participate in an interview. You will be contacted to schedule an interview after all other requirements have been met.
